HOLLYWOOD, FL – The City of Hollywood Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Arts will celebrate the season with the 19th Annual Spring Marshmallow Drop from **2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., Saturday, March 19, at the Boulevard Heights Community Center, 6770 Garfield Street in Hollywood.**

The Open House begins at 2:00 p.m. and will showcase local Civic Associations, karate demonstrations and children's arts & crafts. There will be bounce houses, free popcorn, a DJ providing music and a chance to get your photo with the Easter Bunny. Children under 2, accompanied by a parent, can join in on the fun by visiting the Toddler Zone.

At 4:00 p.m. children ages 3 and 4 may participate in a traditional spring Egg Hunt. At 4:30 p.m. a helicopter will fly overhead and release over 30,000 marshmallows onto the athletic field. Hundreds of children ages 5-12, with baskets and bags in hand, will rush to gather as many marshmallows as they can to be traded in for candy and prizes.
