Child Pornography Arrest

Detectives from the Special Victim's Unit at the Hollywood Police Department, in conjunction with the South Florida Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force (ICAC), conducted an investigation in regards to possible child pornography.

The investigation began in May 2017 after receiving a tip from the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children (NCMEC) who received a cybertip from Dropbox, Inc. The initial tip showed approximately 65 files of apparent child pornography had been uploaded to a Dropbox account under the user name of Christopher Reynoso. Information developed on the IP address came back to a location in Hollywood, Florida.

On Tuesday, November 8, 2017 Hollywood Police along with members of ICAC obtained a residential search warrant. The subject, Christopher Reynoso, was taken into custody without incident. The preliminary investigation revealed more than 180 images/videos in Reynoso's Dropbox account of child victims as young as two to 12 years of age engaging in sexual acts with adults.

Reynoso admitted to storing and viewing the child pornography images/videos. At approximately 2:45 p.m. on Tuesday, November 7, 2017, Reynoso was taken into custody and was arrested and charged with 5 counts of Possession of Child Pornography and 1 count of Possession of Computer Pornography.
