CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

Interstates

I-95 from south of Broward Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impacts:

I-95 will have three lanes closed in each direction Sunday through Thursday night between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. The first two lanes will close at 9 p.m., the third lane at 10 p.m. and the fourth lane at 11 p.m. until 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.

I-95 in both directions, from south of Davie Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard, will have intermittent shoulder and ramp shoulder closures, as needed, daily and nightly.

Powerline Road at the I-95 overpass will have one outside lane closed daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday.

NW 19th Street at the I-95 overpass will have one outside westbound lane closed daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday, beginning Monday, April 8.

Ramp Impact:

The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed, nightly, as needed, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via Commercial Boulevard and Powerline Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The I-95 northbound exit ramps to Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed as needed 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Commercial Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The I-95 northbound exit ramp to eastbound Oakland Park Boulevard will have one inside lane closed daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard will be closed as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Cypress Creek Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard will have one inside lane closed daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from Commercial Boulevard will be closed 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via Powerline Road and Cypress Creek Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Advanced notice: The I-95 southbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard will be closed nightly, Sunday through Thursday, 10 p.m. and 5 a.m., beginning April 7. Traffic will be detoured via Oakland Park Boulevard and I-95. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Description: Work on this 6.7-mile 95 Express project includes widening and converting the existing I-95 HOV Lanes to Managed Lanes which will result in two tolled Express Lanes in each direction; the number of General Use lanes will remain the same. Other work includes: widening bridges, sound wall construction, installation of Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment and ramp signaling at the I-95 entrance ramps at Davie Road, Broward Boulevard, Sunrise Boulevard, Oakland Park Boulevard and Commercial Boulevard. I-95 from north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale to south of SW 10th Street in Deerfield Beach

Restrictions:

I-95 between Commercial Boulevard and SW 10th Street will be have three lanes closed in each direction Sunday through Thursday night. The first lane will close at 10:30 p.m., the second lane at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane at 12:30 a.m. until 5:30 a.m.

One lane in each direction of Cypress Creek Road will be closed daily, 9 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Cypress Creek at I-95 will undergo a full overnight closure for bridge construction, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Eastbound traffic will be detoured via N. Andrews Avenue, I-95 and Commercial Boulevard. Westbound traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Atlantic Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

I-95 Northbound Full Closure Notice: I-95 northbound lanes at Cypress Creek Road will be closed to traffic overnight, 11:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday, March 31 through Thursday, April 4 for overhead sign structure installation.

Detour: Motorists will be detoured via the I-95 northbound exit ramp Cypress Creek Road, S. Dixie Highway and Atlantic Boulevard. Westbound Cypress Creek Road traffic will be detoured via Powerline Road and Atlantic Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists. Please see detour flyer attached.

Description: Work on this 7.3-mile 95 Express project includes widening and converting the existing I-95 HOV Lanes to Managed Lanes which will result in two tolled Express Lanes in each direction; the number of General Use lanes will remain the same. Other work includes widening bridges, sound wall construction, installation of Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment and ramp signaling at the I-95 entrance ramps at Andrews Avenue, Cypress Creek Road and Atlantic Boulevard. I-95 Interchange from Hillsboro Boulevard to SW 10th Street

Ramp Impact:

The I-95 southbound exit ramp to SW 10th Street will be fully closed, as needed, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via Hillsboro Boulevard.

Description: Work on this 1.5-mile interim interchange improvement project includes widening I-95 southbound to add an auxiliary lane from the Hillsboro Boulevard entrance ramp to the SW 10th Street exit ramp, widening the existing I-95 southbound exit ramp to SW 10th Street, addition of a free-flow right turn lane to westbound SW 10th Street and widening of westbound SW 10th Street to add an acceleration lane. Cost/Completion: Construction cost is \$4.5 million. Completion is expected in April 2019.

I-95 from south of SW 10th Street to south of Glades Road (95 Express Phase 3B-1)

Traffic Impact:

I-95 will have three lanes closed in each direction nightly, as needed, Sunday through Thursday, between SW 10th Street and Glades Road, with the first lane closing at 9:30 p.m., the second lane closing at 10:30 p.m., and the third lane closing at 11:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m.

Palmetto Park Road traffic impact:

Palmetto Park Road at I-95 will have two lanes closed in each direction nightly, as needed, Sunday through Thursday. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., and the second lane will close at 10:30 p.m. All lanes will be opened by 5:30 a.m.

Palmetto Park Road at I-95 will have one lane closed in each direction daily, as needed, 9:30 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Camino Real traffic impact:

Camino Real at I-95 will have one lane closed in each direction daily, as needed, 9:30 a.m. until 4 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Full Eastbound Closure: Eastbound Camino Real at I-95 will be closed to all traffic overnight, 10 p.m. until 6 a.m., Tuesday, April 2 and Thursday, April 4 for new bridge construction. Traffic will be detoured via Military Trail, Palmetto Park Road and SW 12th Avenue. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Full Westbound Closure: Westbound Camino Real at I-95 will be closed to all traffic overnight, 10 p.m. until 6 a.m., Wednesday, April 3 for new bridge construction. Traffic will be detoured via SW 12th Avenue, Palmetto Park Road and Military Trail. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Ramp Impact:

The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Palmetto Park Road will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via I-95 northbound, Hillsboro Boulevard, and Military Trail. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Palmetto Park Road eastbound spur ramp will be closed daily, 9:30 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, through mid-April. Motorists can access eastbound Palmetto Park Road via a right turn at the westbound traffic signal.

The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Palmetto Park Road will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via Military Trail and Hillsboro Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Palmetto Park Road will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via Military Trail and Hillsboro Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The northbound entrance ramp from eastbound and westbound Palmetto Park Road will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 southbound to Hillsboro Boulevard to I-95 northbound.

The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from eastbound Hillsboro Boulevard will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via Military Trail and Palmetto Park Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from westbound Hillsboro Boulevard will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via Military Trail and Palmetto Park Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Please note that ramp closures will be performed as needed for paving. Consecutive ramps will not be closed at the same time.

Description: Work on this 4.8-mile 95 Express project includes widening and converting the existing I-95 HOV Lanes to Managed Lanes which will result in two tolled Express Lanes in each direction; the number of General Use lanes will remain the same. Other project improvements include bridge widenings at Palmetto Park Road and Camino Real, complete bridge replacement at the Hillsboro Canal, noise wall construction, portable traffic monitoring sites, toll gantry installation, Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) installation, ramp signaling at the I-95 entrance ramps from Palmetto Park Road, Express Lane markers and landscape relocation. 75 Express from NW 170 Street to south of Miramar Parkway

Traffic Impacts:

One lane in each direction of I-75 from Miramar Parkway to NW 170 Street may be closed Sunday, March 31 through Thursday, April 4 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and or 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Two lanes in each direction of I-75 from Miramar Parkway to NW 170 Street may be closed Sunday, Sunday, March 31 through Thursday, April 4 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and or 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

One southbound lane of I-75 from Bass Creek to the Florida's Turnpike ramp will be closed Sunday, Sunday, March 31 through Thursday, April 4 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

One lane in each direction of I-75 from Miami Gardens Drive to Miramar Parkway will be closed Sunday, March 31 through Thursday, April 4 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

One lane in each direction of Florida's Turnpike from Red Road to Okeechobee Road may be closed Sunday, March 31 through Thursday, April 4 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

One ramp lane in each direction of Florida's Turnpike from Okeechobee Road to I-75 Interchange may be closed Sunday, March 31 through Thursday, April 4 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Description: This 75 Express Lanes project extends 15 miles along I-75 from north of NW 138 Street in Miami-Dade County to I-595 in Broward County. The work is being done in four segments. A four-lane tolled facility has been constructed in the I-75 median, and is separated from the general use lanes by a grass median buffer. The express lanes feature two lanes in each direction, divided by a concrete barrier wall, and full width paved shoulders. **Cost/Completion:** \$485 million/Spring 2019.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard

Detour: Northbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to access Commercial Boulevard will be directed to exit at Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58), travel east on Sunrise Boulevard and travel north on US 441/SR 7 to access Commercial Boulevard. *Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard

Detour: Southbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to access Commercial Boulevard will be directed to exit Coconut Creek Parkway (Exit 67), continue west on Coconut Creek Parkway to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441/SR 7, to access Commercial Boulevard. *Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp from Commercial Boulevard

Full ramp closure, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, March 31 through Thursday, April 4.

Detour: Commercial Boulevard traffic wishing to enter southbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to continue east on Commercial Boulevard to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441/SR 7, to Sunrise Boulevard and travel west on Sunrise Boulevard to access southbound Florida's Turnpike. *Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp from Commercial Boulevard

Full ramp closure, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, March 31 through Thursday, April 4.

Detour: Commercial Boulevard traffic wishing to enter southbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to continue east on Commercial Boulevard to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441/SR 7 to Sunrise Boulevard and travel west on Sunrise Boulevard to access southbound Florida's Turnpike. *Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.

Northbound Sawgrass exit ramp to northbound Florida's Turnpike

Description: Work consists of providing all labor, materials, equipment, and incidentals necessary to continue with the complete conversion of the Turnpike Mainline to an All Electronic Toll (AET) collection system. The overall AET conversion scope includes: milling and resurfacing, base work, drainage improvements, curb & gutter, lighting, highway signing, guardrail, MSE walls, toll facilities and other incidental construction on SR 91(Turnpike Mainline) from I-595 (MP 54) to South of Lantana Toll Plaza (MP 88) for 34 miles in Broward and Palm Beach Counties. Construction to begin in Summer 2018 through Summer 2020.

Cost / Completion: \$20.4 million. / Summer 2020

Turnpike & Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) Interchange Modifications

Traffic Impact:

Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound between Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) and Broward Boulevard, double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, March 31st thru Thursday, April 4th. A third lane in each direction may close beginning at 11 p.m. All lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.

Ramp Closure: The southbound entrance ramp from Sunrise Boulevard to Florida's Turnpike will be closed from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Sunday, March 31st thru Thursday, April 4th. This closure is to accommodate a traffic shift on the Access Road.

Detour: Motorists will be directed to travel east on Sunrise Boulevard to SR 7/US 441, then travel south to the westbound ramp to I-595 and follow the signs to access southbound Turnpike. *As an alternate to the this detour, motorists should be aware that the new AET Southbound Entrance ramp from Eastbound Sunrise Blvd. will be open and can be used to access Southbound Turnpike.

Ramp Closure: Florida's Turnpike southbound exit ramp to Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) will be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Sunday, March 31st thru Thursday, April 4th. This closure to accommodate a traffic shift on the Access Road.

Detour: Motorists will be directed south to exit at I-595 East and continue to SR 7/US 441 North, and continue north to access Sunrise Boulevard.

One lane on Sunrise Boulevard eastbound and westbound between NW 47th Avenue and NW 56th Avenue, will be closed nightly between 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., and a second lane may close in each direction beginning at 10 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., Sunday, March 31st through Thursday, April 4th. Broward Boulevard Improvements and Bridge Replacement Project in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

One lane will be closed periodically on NW 31st between Broward Boulevard and Commercial Boulevard will be closed Monday through Friday between 8:30 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. and Sunday through Thursday night for pavement marking until the completion of the project.

Traffic Impact:
