### CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

#### Interstates

I-95 from south of Broward Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale

#### Traffic Impacts:

I-95 will have three lanes closed in each direction Sunday through Thursday night between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. The first two lanes will close at 9 p.m., the third lane at 10 p.m. and the fourth lane at 11 p.m. until 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.

I-95 in both directions, from south of Davie Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard, will have intermittent shoulder and ramp shoulder closures, as needed, daily and nightly.

Powerline Road at the I-95 overpass will have one outside lane closed daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday.

NW 19th Street at the I-95 overpass will have one outside lane closed, daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday,  
beginning Monday, April 8.

Powerline Road at I-95 will have two lanes closed in each direction, nightly, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.

#### Ramp Impact:

The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed, nightly, as needed, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via Commercial Boulevard and Powerline Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The I-95 northbound exit ramps to Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed as needed 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Commercial Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The I-95 northbound exit ramp to eastbound Oakland Park Boulevard will have one inside lane closed daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard will be closed as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Cypress Creek Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard will have one inside lane closed daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from Commercial Boulevard will be closed 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via Powerline Road and Cypress Creek Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The I-95 southbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard will be closed nightly, Sunday through Thursday, 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via Oakland Park Boulevard and I-95. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Description: Work on this 6.7-mile 95 Express project includes widening and converting the existing I-95 HOV Lanes to Managed Lanes which will result in two tolled Express Lanes in each direction; the number of General Use lanes will remain the same. Other work includes: widening bridges, sound wall construction, installation of Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment and ramp signaling at the I-95 entrance ramps at Davie Road, Broward Boulevard, Sunrise Boulevard, Oakland Park Boulevard and Commercial Boulevard. I-95 from north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale to south of SW 10th Street in Deerfield Beach

#### Restrictions:

I-95 between Commercial Boulevard and SW 10th Street will be have three lanes closed in each direction Sunday through Thursday night. The first lane will close at 10:30 p.m., the second lane at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane at 12:30 a.m. until 5:30 a.m.

One lane in each direction of Cypress Creek Road will be closed daily, 9 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Cypress Creek at I-95 will undergo a full overnight closure for bridge construction, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Eastbound traffic will be detoured via N. Andrews Avenue, I-95 and Commercial Boulevard. Westbound traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Atlantic Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

I-95 Northbound Full Closure Notice: I-95 northbound lanes at Cypress Creek Road will be closed to traffic overnight, 11:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Monday, April 8 through Thursday, April 11 for overhead sign structure installation.

Detour: Motorists will be detoured via the I-95 northbound exit ramp Cypress Creek Road, S. Dixie Highway and Atlantic Boulevard. Westbound Cypress Creek Road traffic will be detoured via Powerline Road and Atlantic Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists. Please see detour flyer attached.

I-95 Southbound Full Closure Advanced Notice: I-95 southbound lanes at Atlantic Boulevard will be closed to traffic overnight, 11:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday, April 14 through Thursday, April 18 for overhead sign structure and toll gantry installation.

Detour: Motorists will be detoured via the I-95 southbound exit ramp to Atlantic Boulevard, N. Andrews Avenue and Cypress Creek Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

I-95 Southbound Full Closure Advanced Notice: I-95 southbound lanes at SW 10th Street will be closed to traffic overnight, 11:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Monday, April 22 for bridge construction.

Detour: Traffic will be detoured via the I-95 southbound exit ramp to SW 10th Street, Military Trail and Sample Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorist. Please see detour flyer attached.

I-95 Northbound Full Closure Advanced Notice: I-95 northbound lanes at Sample Road will be closed to traffic overnight, 11:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Tuesday, April 23 for bridge construction.

Detour: Traffic will be detoured via the I-95 northbound exit ramp to Sample Road, S. Dixie Highway and SW 10th Street. FHP will be on site to assist motorist. Please see detour flyer attached.

Description: Work on this 7.3-mile 95 Express project includes widening and converting the existing I-95 HOV Lanes to Managed Lanes which will result in two tolled Express Lanes in each direction; the number of General Use lanes will remain the same. Other work includes widening bridges, sound wall construction, installation of Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment and ramp signaling at the I-95 entrance ramps at Andrews Avenue, Cypress Creek Road and Atlantic Boulevard. I-95 Interchange from Hillsboro Boulevard to SW 10th Street

Traffic Impact:

None anticipated.

Description: Work on this 1.5-mile interim interchange improvement project includes widening I-95 southbound to add an auxiliary lane from the Hillsboro Boulevard entrance ramp to the SW 10th Street exit ramp, widening the existing I-95 southbound exit ramp to SW 10th Street, addition of a free-flow right turn lane to westbound SW 10th Street and widening of westbound SW 10th Street to add an acceleration lane. I-95 from south of SW 10th Street to south of Glades Road (95 Express Phase 3B-1)

Traffic Impact:

I-95 will have three lanes closed in each direction nightly, as needed, Sunday through Thursday, between SW 10th Street and Glades Road, with the first lane closing at 9:30 p.m., the second lane closing at 10:30 p.m., and the third lane closing at 11:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m.

Palmetto Park Road traffic impact:

Palmetto Park Road at I-95 will have two lanes closed in each direction nightly, as needed, Sunday through Thursday. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., and the second lane will close at 10:30 p.m. All lanes will be opened by 5:30 a.m.

Palmetto Park Road at I-95 will have one lane closed in each direction daily, as needed, 9:30 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Camino Real traffic impact:

Camino Real at I-95 will have one lane closed in each direction daily, as needed, 9:30 a.m. until 4 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Full Eastbound Closure: Eastbound Camino Real at I-95 will be closed to all traffic overnight, 10 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday, April 7 and Tuesday, April 9 for new bridge construction. Traffic will be detoured via Military Trail, Palmetto Park Road and SW 12th Avenue. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Full Westbound Closure: Westbound Camino Real at I-95 will be closed to all traffic overnight, 10 p.m. until 6 a.m., Monday, April 8 and Wednesday, April 10 for new bridge construction. Traffic will be detoured via SW 12th Avenue, Palmetto Park Road and Military Trail. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Ramp Impact:

The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Palmetto Park Road will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via I-95 northbound, Hillsboro Boulevard, and Military Trail. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Palmetto Park Road eastbound spur ramp will be closed daily, 9:30 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, through mid-April. Motorists can access eastbound Palmetto Park Road via a right turn at the westbound traffic signal.

The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Palmetto Park Road will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via Military Trail and Hillsboro Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Palmetto Park Road will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via Military Trail and Hillsboro Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The northbound entrance ramp from eastbound and westbound Palmetto Park Road will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 southbound to Hillsboro Boulevard to I-95 northbound.

The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from eastbound Hillsboro Boulevard will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via Military Trail and Palmetto Park Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from westbound Hillsboro Boulevard will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via Military Trail and Palmetto Park Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Please note that ramp closures will be performed as needed for paving. Consecutive ramps will not be closed at the same time.

Description: Work on this 4.8-mile 95 Express project includes widening and converting the existing I-95 HOV Lanes to Managed Lanes which will result in two tolled Express Lanes in each direction; the number of General Use lanes will remain the same. Other project improvements include bridge widenings at Palmetto Park Road and Camino Real, complete bridge replacement at the Hillsboro Canal, noise wall construction, portable traffic monitoring sites, toll gantry installation, Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) installation, ramp signaling at the I-95 entrance ramps from Palmetto Park Road, Express Lane markers and landscape relocation. One lane in each direction of I-75 from Miramar Parkway to NW 170 Street may be closed Sunday, April 7 through Thursday, April 11 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

One lane in each direction of 75 Express from Miramar to NW 170 Street may be closed Sunday, April 7 through Thursday, April 11 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

One lane in each direction of Florida's Turnpike from Red Road to Okeechobee Road may be closed Sunday, April 7 through Thursday, April 11 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

One ramp lane in each direction of Florida's Turnpike from Okeechobee Road to I-75 Interchange may be closed Sunday, April 7 through Thursday, April 11 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to access Hollywood Boulevard will be directed to exit at Griffin Road (Exit 53), travel east on Griffin Road to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441/SR 7 to access Hollywood Boulevard. \*Please note the southbound closure will not occur at the same time as the Hollywood Boulevard exit ramp closure.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to access Hollywood Boulevard will be directed to exit at Griffin Road (Exit 53), travel east on Griffin Road to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441/SR 7 to access Hollywood Boulevard.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to Griffin Road (Exit 53)

Full ramp closure, 9 p.m. to 4 a.m., Thursday, April 7 through Monday, April 11.

Detour information:

Southbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to access Griffin Road will be directed to exit at US 441/SR 7 (Exit 54), follow signs for US 44/SR 7 South and travel south on US 441/SR 7 to access Griffin Road.

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike between Okeechobee Road and Red Road

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike between NW 27th Avenue and NW 57th Avenue

Single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, April 7 through Thursday, April 11.

Project Description: The Turnpike will be widened from four to eight lanes. Work includes intersection improvements at Red Road/NW 57th Avenue and University Drive/ NW 27th Avenue. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Bridge widening, road milling and resurfacing, signage and traffic signal improvements are planned. Construction began in September 2018 will continue through summer 2022. Approximate cost: \$143 million.

Eastbound and westbound Sunrise Boulevard between NW 47th Avenue and NW 56th Avenue

Single lane closures, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 7 through Thursday, April 11.

If necessary, a second lane will close beginning at 10 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 6 a.m.

Eastbound and westbound Sunrise Boulevard between NW 47th Avenue and NW 56th Avenue

Single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, April 8 through Friday, April 12.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp from Sunrise Boulevard

Full ramp closure, 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, April 9 through Thursday, April 11.

Detour information:

Sunrise Boulevard traffic wishing to enter northbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to travel east on Sunrise Boulevard to US 441/SR 7, travel north on US 441/SR 7 to Commercial Boulevard and travel west on Commercial Boulevard to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp from Sunrise Boulevard

Full ramp closure, 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, April 9 through Thursday, April 11.

Detour information:

Sunrise Boulevard traffic wishing to enter southbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to travel east on Sunrise Boulevard to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441/SR 7 to the westbound I-595 ramp to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58)

Full ramp closure, 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, April 9 through Thursday, April 11.

Detour information:

Southbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to access Sunrise Boulevard will be directed to exit at I-595 (Exit 54), travel east on I-595 to US 441/SR 7 and travel north on US 441/SR 7 to access Sunrise Boulevard.

Description: Florida's Turnpike is modifying and improving the interchange with Sunrise Boulevard and implementing All-Electronic Tolling at the interchange. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$50 million and work will continue through late 2019.

Broward Boulevard Improvements and Bridge Replacement Project in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

One or two Eastbound/Westbound lanes will be closed along Broward Boulevard Monday through Friday between 10:00 p.m. to 6 a.m. and Saturday between 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. until the completion of the project for punch lists and remaining pay item works on signalization.

One outside Westbound lane will be closed along Broward Boulevard from Brickell Avenue to NW 15th Avenue from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. for directional boring work and rerouting of the ITS lines

SR 811 / NE 4 Avenue / Wilton Drive Complete Streets Project in Fort Lauderdale and Wilton Manors

Traffic Impact:



One lane southbound along NE 4th Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale from NE 12th St to NE 11th St will be permanently closed.

One lane northbound SR 811 / NE 4th Avenue / Wilton Drive from NE 20th Street to NE 9th Avenue will be permanently closed.

One lane southbound SR 811 / NE 4th Avenue / Wilton Drive from NE 20th Street to NE 6th Avenue will be permanently closed.

One lane southbound SR 811 / NE 4th Avenue / Wilton Drive from NE 6th Ave to NE 22nd St southbound will be temporarily closed during the day for the relocation of low-profile barriers.
