CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

Interstates

I-95 from south of Broward Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impacts:

I-95 will have three lanes closed in each direction Sunday through Thursday night between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. The first two lanes will close at 9 p.m., the third lane at 10 p.m. and the fourth lane at 11 p.m. until 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.

I-95 in both directions, from south of Davie Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard, will have intermittent shoulder and ramp shoulder closures, as needed, daily and nightly.

Powerline Road at the I-95 overpass will have one lane closed daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday.

NW 19th Street at the I-95 overpass will have one lane closed, daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday.

NW 19th Street at the I-95 overpass will undergo a full closure, as needed, for up to 20 minutes at a time, 11:30 p.m. until 1 a.m., Monday night, April 29 and Tuesday night, April 30 to safely move equipment. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Powerline Road at I-95 will have two lanes closed in each direction, nightly, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.

Ramp Impact:

The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed, nightly, as needed, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via Commercial Boulevard and Powerline Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The I-95 northbound exit ramps to Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed as needed 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Commercial Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The I-95 northbound exit ramp to eastbound Oakland Park Boulevard will have one inside lane closed daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard will be closed as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Cypress Creek Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard will have one inside lane closed daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from Commercial Boulevard will be closed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via Powerline Road and Cypress Creek Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

The I-95 southbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard will be closed nightly, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via Oakland Park Boulevard and I-95. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Advanced Notice: The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Sunrise Boulevard will be closed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, beginning Sunday, May 5. Traffic will be detoured via Oakland Park Boulevard and I-95. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Advanced Notice: The I-95 southbound entrance ramps from Commercial Boulevard will be closed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, beginning Sunday, May 12. Traffic will be detoured via Powerline Road, Oakland Park Boulevard and I-95. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Advanced Notice: The I-95 southbound entrance ramps from Cypress Creek Road will be closed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, beginning Sunday, May 12. Traffic will be detoured via Andrews Avenue, Commercial Boulevard and I-95. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Description: Work on this 6.7-mile 95 Express project includes widening and converting the existing I-95 HOV Lanes to Managed Lanes which will result in two tolled Express Lanes in each direction; the number of General Use lanes will remain the same. Other work includes: widening bridges, sound wall construction, installation of Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment and ramp signaling at the I-95 entrance

ramps at Davie Road, Broward Boulevard, Sunrise Boulevard, Oakland Park Boulevard and Commercial Boulevard. I-95 from north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale to south of SW 10th Street in Deerfield Beach

Restrictions:

I-95 between Commercial Boulevard and SW 10th Street will be have three lanes closed in each direction Monday night through Thursday night. The first lane will close at 10:30 p.m., the second lane at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane at 12:30 a.m. until 5:30 a.m.

One lane in each direction of Cypress Creek Road will be closed daily, 9 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Cypress Creek at I-95 will undergo a full overnight closure for bridge construction, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Monday night through Thursday night. Eastbound traffic will be detoured via N. Andrews Avenue, I-95 and Commercial Boulevard. Westbound traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Atlantic Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

I-95 Northbound Full Closure Notice: I-95 northbound lanes at Cypress Creek Road will be closed to traffic overnight, 11:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Monday night, April 22 through Thursday night, April 25 for overhead sign structure installation and toll gantry installation.

Detour: Motorists will be detoured via the I-95 northbound exit ramp Cypress Creek Road, S. Dixie Highway and Atlantic Boulevard. Westbound Cypress Creek Road traffic will be detoured via Powerline Road and Atlantic Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists. Please see detour flyer attached.

I-95 Southbound Full Closure Advanced Notice: I-95 southbound lanes at Copans Road will be closed to traffic overnight, 11:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Wednesday night, May 1 and Thursday night, May 2 for overhead sign structure and toll gantry installation.

Detour: Motorists will be detoured via the I-95 southbound exit ramp to Copans, N. Andrews Avenue and Atlantic Blvd. Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

I-95 Southbound Full Closure Advanced Notice: I-95 southbound lanes at SW 10th Street will be closed to traffic overnight, 11:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday night, April 28 for bridge construction.

Detour: Traffic will be detoured via the I-95 southbound exit ramp to SW 10th Street, Military Trail and Sample Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorist. Please see detour flyer attached.

I-95 Northbound Full Closure Advanced Notice: I-95 northbound lanes at Sample Road will be closed to traffic overnight, 11:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday night, May 5 for bridge construction.

Detour: Traffic will be detoured via the I-95 northbound exit ramp to Sample Road, S. Dixie Highway and SW 10th Street. FHP will be on site to assist motorists. Please see detour flyer attached.

Description: Work on this 7.3-mile 95 Express project includes widening and converting the existing I-95 HOV Lanes to Managed Lanes which will result in two tolled Express Lanes in each direction; the number of General Use lanes will remain the same. Other work includes widening bridges, sound wall construction, installation of Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment and ramp signaling at the I-95 entrance ramps at Andrews Avenue, Cypress Creek Road and Atlantic Boulevard. I-95 Interchange from Hillsboro Boulevard to SW 10th Street

Traffic Impact:

None anticipated.

Description: Work on this 1.5-mile interim interchange improvement project includes widening I-95 southbound to add an auxiliary lane from the Hillsboro Boulevard entrance ramp to the SW 10th Street exit ramp, widening the existing I-95 southbound exit ramp to SW 10th Street, addition of a free-flow right turn lane to westbound SW 10th Street and widening of westbound SW 10th Street to add an acceleration lane. Cost/Completion: Construction cost is \$4.5 million. Completion is expected in April 2019.

I-95 from south of SW 10th Street to south of Glades Road (95 Express Phase 3B-1)

Traffic Impact:

- I-95 will have three lanes closed in each direction nightly, as needed, Sunday through Thursday, between SW 10th Street and Glades Road, with the first lane closing at 9:30 p.m., the second lane closing at 10:30 p.m., and the third lane closing at 11:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m.
- Palmetto Park Road at I-95 will have two lanes closed in each direction nightly, as needed, Sunday through Thursday. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., and the second lane will close at 10:30 p.m. All lanes will be opened by 5:30 a.m.
- Palmetto Park Road at I-95 will have one lane closed in each direction daily, as needed, 9:30 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- Camino Real at I-95 will have one lane closed in each direction daily, as needed, 9:30 a.m. until 4 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- **Full Closure Notice:** Camino Real at I-95 will undergo a complete closure for new bridge deck construction, 10 p.m. until 6 a.m., Monday night, April 22 and Monday night, April 29. Traffic will be detoured via Military Trail, Palmetto Park Road, and SW 12th Avenue. FHP will be on site to assist motorists. Please see detour flyer attached.

- The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Palmetto Park Road will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via I-95 northbound, Hillsboro Boulevard, and Military Trail. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Palmetto Park Road eastbound spur ramp will be closed daily, 9:30 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, through April. Motorists can access eastbound Palmetto Park Road via a right turn at the westbound traffic signal.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Palmetto Park Road will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via Military Trail and Hillsboro Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Palmetto Park Road will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via Military Trail and Hillsboro Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The northbound entrance ramp from eastbound and westbound Palmetto Park Road will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 southbound to Hillsboro Boulevard to I-95 northbound.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from eastbound Hillsboro Boulevard will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via Military Trail and Palmetto Park Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from westbound Hillsboro Boulevard will be closed nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via Military Trail and Palmetto Park Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists. Please note that ramp closures will be performed as needed per paving production; consecutive ramps will not be closed at the same time. Description: Work on this 4.8-mile 95 Express project includes widening and converting the existing I-95 HOV Lanes to Managed Lanes which will result in two tolled Express Lanes in each direction; the number of General Use lanes will remain the same. Other project improvements include bridge widenings at Palmetto Park Road and Camino Real, complete bridge replacement at the Hillsboro Canal, noise wall construction, portable traffic monitoring sites, toll gantry installation, Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) installation, ramp signaling at the I-95 entrance ramps from Palmetto Park Road, Express Lane markers and landscape relocation. 75 Express from NW 170 Street to south of Miramar Parkway

Traffic Impacts:

- One lane in each direction of I-75 from Miramar Parkway to NW 170 Street may be closed Friday, April 18 through Thursday, April 25 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- One lane in each direction of Florida's Turnpike from Red Road to Okeechobee Road may be closed Sunday, April 21 through Thursday, April 25 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- One ramp lane in each direction of Florida's Turnpike from Okeechobee Road to I-75 Interchange may be closed Sunday, April 21 through Thursday, April 25 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Description: This 75 Express Lanes project extends 15 miles along I-75 from north of NW 138 Street in Miami-Dade County to I-595 in Broward County. The work is being done in four segments. A four-lane tolled facility has been constructed in the I-75 median, and is separated from the general use lanes by a grass median buffer. The express lanes feature two lanes in each direction, divided by a concrete barrier wall, and full width paved shoulders. **Cost/Completion:** \$485 million/Spring 2019.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to access Commercial Boulevard will be directed to exit Coconut Creek Parkway (Exit 67), continue west on Coconut Creek Parkway to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441/SR 7, to access Commercial Boulevard. **Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.*

Southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp from Commercial Boulevard

Commercial Boulevard traffic wishing to enter southbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to continue east on Commercial Boulevard to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441/SR 7, to Sunrise Boulevard and travel west on Sunrise Boulevard to access southbound Florida's Turnpike. **Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.*

Northbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp from Commercial Boulevard

- Full ramp closure, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, April 14 through Thursday, April 18.

Detour information:

Commercial Boulevard traffic wishing to enter southbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to continue east on Commercial Boulevard to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441/SR 7 to Sunrise Boulevard and travel west on Sunrise Boulevard to access southbound Florida's Turnpike. **Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.*

Northbound Sawgrass exit ramp to northbound Florida's Turnpike

Northbound Sawgrass Expressway traffic wishing to enter northbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to exit at Lyons Road (Exit 19), travel south on Lyons Road and travel east on Sample Road to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.

Description: Work consists of providing all labor, materials, equipment, and incidentals necessary to continue with the complete conversion of the Turnpike Mainline to an All Electronic Toll (AET) collection system. The overall AET conversion scope includes: milling and resurfacing, base work, drainage improvements, curb & gutter, lighting, highway signing, guardrail, MSE walls, toll facilities and other incidental construction on SR 91 (Turnpike Mainline) from I-595 (MP 54) to South of Lantana Toll Plaza (MP 88) for 34 miles in Broward and Palm Beach Counties. Construction to begin in Summer 2018 through Summer 2020.

Cost / Completion: \$20.4 million. / Summer 2020

Turnpike & Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) Interchange Modifications

Traffic Impact:

- Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound between Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) and Broward Boulevard, double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, April 14th thru Thursday, April 18th. A third lane in each direction may close beginning at 11 p.m. All lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- Sunrise Boulevard eastbound and westbound between NW 47th Avenue and NW 56th Avenue, a single lane in each direction closed nightly between 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., and a second lane may close in each direction beginning at 10 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., Sunday, April 14th through Thursday, April 18th; Also, Single lane closures daily between 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, April 15th through Friday, April 19th.
- The northbound entrance ramp from Sunrise Boulevard to Florida's Turnpike will be closed from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Sunday, April 14th. This closure is to accommodate demolition activities on the Access Road.
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel east on Sunrise Boulevard to SR 7/US 441, then travel north to Commercial Boulevard and west to the Florida Turnpike entrance ramp.
- The southbound entrance ramp from Sunrise Boulevard to Florida's Turnpike will be closed from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Sunday, April 14th. This closure is to accommodate a traffic shift on the Access Road.

- DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel east on Sunrise Boulevard to SR 7/US 441, then travel south to the westbound ramp to I-595 and follow the signs to access southbound Turnpike.
- As an alternate to the above detour, motorists should be aware that the new AET Southbound Entrance ramp from Eastbound Sunrise Blvd. will be open and can be used to access Southbound Turnpike.

Description: Florida’s Turnpike is modifying and improving the interchange with Sunrise Boulevard and implementing All-Electronic Tolling at the interchange. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$50 million and work will continue through late 2019. Northeast Broward

Broward Boulevard Improvements and Bridge Replacement Project in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- One or two eastbound and/or westbound lanes will be closed along Broward Boulevard Monday through Friday nightly from 10:00 p.m. to 6 a.m. and Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. until the completion of the project for minor repairs and signalization work.
- One outside westbound lane will be closed along Broward Boulevard from Brickell Avenue to NW 15th Avenue Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. for directional boring work and rerouting of the ITS lines. Some parts of the north sidewalk are closed where the operations are occurring.

Description: Project improvements include replacing the bridge over the North Fork of the New River, removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway, upgrading crosswalk ramps to meet ADA requirements, upgrading signs and pavement markings, relocating bus shelters, adding roadway lighting, installing drainage structures, upgrading signalized intersections to mast arms, reconstructing sidewalks, and widening roadway to add bike lanes in each direction. SR 811 / NE 4 Avenue / Wilton Drive Complete Streets Project in Fort Lauderdale and Wilton Manors

Traffic Impact:

- One southbound lane on NE 4th Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale from NE 12th Street to NE 11th Street will be permanently closed.
- One northbound lane on SR 811 / NE 4th Avenue / Wilton Drive from NE 20th Street to NE 9th Avenue will be permanently closed.
- One southbound lane on SR 811 / NE 4th Avenue / Wilton Drive from NE 20th Street to NE 6th Avenue will be permanently closed.

- One southbound lane on SR 811 / NE 4th Avenue / Wilton Drive from NE 6th Avenue to NE 22nd Street will be temporarily closed during the day for the relocation of low-profile barriers.

Description: Project improvements include removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway, upgrading signs and pavement markings, adding a buffered bike lane in each direction, widening sidewalks, upgrading pedestrian signals and modifying pedestrian curb ramps to meet ADA requirements, upgrading roadway and pedestrian lighting, and installing new drainage structures and upgrading the existing drainage system. NW 19 Street Bike Lanes and Rehabilitation Project in Lauderdale Lakes, Lauderhill, and Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction will be closed on NW 19th Street from SR 7 to NW 31st Avenue Monday through Friday between 8:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. for milling and resurfacing.

Description: The improvements under this contract consist of added bike lanes along NW 19th St. via lane width reduction with milling and resurfacing, sidewalk and driveways, ADA ramps with detectable warnings, drainage improvements, curb and gutter, bus shelter relocations, signing and pavement markings, and signalization with pedestrian detectors and lighting including LED retrofit at specific locations. Lighting Retrofit Improvements Project
