APPLICATION FOR A CAMPFIRE

The granting of a Burn Permit by the Hollywood Fire-Rescue and Beach Safety Department is not authorization or license for an event. A Burn Permit from the Hollywood Fire-Rescue and Beach Safety Department evaluates only the safety aspects of the burn and provides a permit for such burn, provided all other municipal, county, state, and federal requirements are met by the petitioner(s).

All campfires must comply to the following criteria:

1. The diameter of the fire can not exceed 36 inches.
2. The height of the stack of wood used for kindling will be no greater than 18 inches from the ground.
3. Only clean wood, tree branches or charcoal can be used.
4. An area at least two feet wide around the entire circumference must be clear of all combustible material.
5. The fire must be on the ground or a specially prepared surface designed for a campfire.
6. The campfire must be outdoors and not inside any type of structure.
7. The fire can be no closer than 50 feet to any structure.

There is a \$50.00 fee for the Burn Permit.
(City of Hollywood Code of Ordinances 94.173)

A letter from the property owner granting permission to conduct the campfire at his/her property must accompany the application. If the property has insurance then they also need a letter from the insurance company stating it is alright to conduct the campfire. The letter(s) must be notarized. This is only required if the location is one that ordinarily does not conduct campfires.

An **Open Burn License** from the Broward County Department of Natural Resource Protection, **Division of Air Quality** must be obtained if the campfire is for anything other than outdoor noncommercial preparation of food.

Once all of the above have been received a determination as to whether a permit will be issued will be made.

If on City of Hollywood property a **“RECREATIONAL CAMPFIRE ON CITY PROPERTY PERMIT AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT”** must be executed.

The permit may be revoked at any time when, in the opinion of the Fire Chief, Fire Marshal or other duly authorized representative of the Fire Department, conditions are such as to create a hazard to the public or the surrounding area.
