TRI-RAIL ANTICIPATES POSSIBLE DELAYS DUE TO TRACK WORK

Tri-Rail passengers may experience potential delays of up to 15 minutes beginning Tuesday, November 10 and continuing for approximately the next six weeks due to track work. Delays could occur Tuesday through Friday as crews work to maintain the track for maximum safety and reliability. The work will take place on approximately 62 miles of "Main Line 1," as part of the ongoing maintenance program. Work will be done during the late evening and early morning hours, when Tri-Rail trains do not operate.

It is possible that train speed restrictions, applied to sections of the track, could cause intermittent delays during the day to some Tri-Rail trains. The South Florida Regional Transportation Authority, CSX Transportation and Florida Department of Transportation are working together to minimize the impact to passengers. CSX Transportation is providing special track equipment expected to minimize the length of time train speed restrictions are in effect.

There is also the possibility of some road closures during the length of construction. CSX Transportation is working with the FDOT to reduce any inconvenience to drivers. Advance notification will be made prior to closures occurring.
