NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Commission of the City of Hollywood, Florida, is advertising for sealed bids (one original and three copies) which shall be **submitted to the City Clerk's Office** (City Hall, 2600 Hollywood Boulevard, Room 221) of the City of Hollywood, Florida, **until 2:00 p.m.**, local time, **August 17, 2010**. On August 17, 2010 at 2:30 p.m. the bids will be opened and read publicly in the Department of Public Utilities, Engineering and Construction Services Division Conference Room at 1621 North 14th Avenue, Hollywood, Florida.

A pre-bid meeting will be held July 29, 2010 at 1:30 p.m. at the Southern Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant located at 1621 North 14th Avenue, Hollywood, Florida, 33020, Building A.

The Bid Package and Contract documents may also be obtained at a cost of \$50.00 from the Department of Public Utilities, Engineering and Construction Services Division at 1621 North 14th Avenue in Hollywood. Technical assistance shall be submitted in writing to the Project Manager, Jeff Jiang, P.E., by no later than August 9, 2010.

Each bid must be accompanied by a Bid Security, in an amount no less than ten percent (10%) of the bid amount. Said security shall be in the form of a Certified Check or Cashier's Check on a solvent National or State Bank, or a bid bond executed by the Bidder and a qualified Surety, satisfactory and payable to the City of Hollywood, Florida.

A Cone of Silence is in effect with respect to this bid. The Cone of Silence prohibits certain communications between potential vendors and the City. For further information, please refer to Section 30.15(E) of the City's Code of Ordinances.

It will be the sole responsibility of the Bidder to deliver personally or by mail, his/her proposal to the City Clerk's Office at City Hall on or before the closing hour and date for the receipt of bids as noted above.

The City Commission reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive informalities and to accept or reject all or any part of any bid, as they may deem to be in the best interest of the City of Hollywood, Florida.
