GENERAL NOTES RELATED TO REVELANT REQUEST RECEIVED FROM POTENTIAL RESPONDENTS:

1. Questions from Mr. Jim Thompson, Thompson & Associates, Inc.:

Question No. 1. *Does the City currently have an easement for the proposed direction drill alignment?*

Response: No.

Question No. 2. *Does the City have a jurisdictional wetland survey or sea grass survey for the path of the directional drill alignments?*

Response: Since the Design Build Firm (DBF) is responsible for the design and construction of the project, all necessary survey shall be implemented during design and permitting application.

Question No. 3. *Does the City have as-built information for the 60" ocean outfall pipe near the west construction site on Johnson Street in Holland Park?*

Response: Yes. Record information will be provided to the DBF after the contract is awarded.

2. Questions from Mr. Jorge Calvo , Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc.:

Question No. 1. *Has the City-owned yard west of A1A and South of E-03 been tested for contaminated soils?*

Response: No. Since the DBF is responsible for the design and construction of the project, the project approach and implementation details shall be addressed as part of the Design–Build contract.

Question No. 2. *Is the City-owned yard located South of Washington Street, and East of, and across the alley from, the City Parking Garage available for setting up equipment?*

Response: Since the DBF is responsible for the design and construction of the project, the project approach and implementation details shall be addressed as part of the Design–Build contract.

Question No. 3. *Can the parking garage on Washington Street and A1A be accessed from another entry/exit point and the one from Washington Street closed during construction of the E-03 crossings?*

Response: Since the DBF is responsible for the design and construction of the project, the project approach and implementation details shall be addressed as part of the Design–Build contract.

Question No. 4. *Can the City provide old aerial photos of the areas of the 2 crossings?*

Response: Yes, City will provide all pertinent information currently on record. However, the DBF will be responsible for obtaining all necessary record information to successfully design and construct the project.

Question No. 5. *Have any of the regulatory agencies mentioned in the RFQ been contacted about the crossings? And have they provided any guidance about the depth and/or locations of the crossings?*

Response: All permitting is responsibility of the DBF.

Question No. 6. *Will the City schedule a pre-bid meeting and site walkthrough where we can access the 2 pump stations?*

Response: No. Since it is a Request for Qualification process, no detail bidding effort is expected at this status.

Question No. 7. *Can Holland Park be closed while the pipes are strung and assembled?*

Response: Holland Park is a City owned park. However, the DBF is responsible for the design and construction of the project, the project approach and implementation details shall be addressed as part of the Design-Build contract.

Question No. 8. *What is the source of the funding for this project so we have an idea as to the conditions we'll be facing?*

Response: The project will be funded by the expected City of Hollywood – Series 2009 Revenue Bonds.

Question No. 9. *Define clearly if the Broward County MBE's are accepted as locals. When limited to a very small demographic area it's usually very difficult to find qualified firms. Please confirm.*

Response: Broward County MBE's **ARE NOT** accepted as local MBE/SBE. Local MBE/SBE is defined as the City of Hollywood's local MBE/SBE. Qualified MBE/SBE are listed in the Local Qualified MBE/SBE directory which is published at City of Hollywood's official website.
