NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Commission of the City of Hollywood, Florida, is advertising for sealed bids which shall be **submitted to the City Clerk's Office** (City Hall, 2600 Hollywood Boulevard, Room 221) of the City of Hollywood, Florida, **until Thursday, July 8, 2010 at 10:00am**, local time at which time they will be opened and read publicly in the Department of Public Utilities, Engineering & Construction Services Division Conference Room at 2717 Van Buren Street, Hollywood, Florida.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held on Friday, June 25, 2010 at 9:30am at the site located at 2030 Polk Street, Hollywood.

The Bid Package and any other Contract documents may be obtained from the Department of Public Utilities, Engineering & Construction Services Division at 2717 Van Buren Street in Hollywood. The first copy to all eligible bidders will be provided at no cost. Additional copies will be furnished upon request for a nominal fee. Each bid must be accompanied by a Bid Security, in an amount no less than ten percent (10%) of the bid amount. Said security shall be in the form of a Certified Check or Cashier's Check on a solvent National or State Bank, or a bid bond executed by the Bidder and a qualified Surety, satisfactory and payable to the City of Hollywood, Florida.

A Cone of Silence is in effect with respect to this bid. The Cone of Silence prohibits certain communications between potential vendors and the City. For further information, please refer to Section 30.15(E) of the City's Code of Ordinances.

It will be the sole responsibility of the Bidder to deliver personally or by mail, his/her proposal to the City Clerk's Office at City Hall on or before the closing hour and date for the receipt of bids as noted above.

The City Commission reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive informalities and to accept or reject all or any part of any bid, as they may deem to be in the best interest of the City of Hollywood, Florida.
