NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the City Commission of the City of Hollywood, Florida is advertising for Sealed Bids which will be received by the City Clerk of the City of Hollywood, Florida at City Hall, 2600 Hollywood Blvd., Room 221, Hollywood, Florida 33020 until **3:00 P.M., Wednesday, August 4, 2010**, at which time they will be opened and publicly read in the Procurement Services Office, Room 303, City Hall, 2600 Hollywood Boulevard, Hollywood, Florida. FOR: **Pressure Cleaning Services**

Please make the following changes (additions, deletions or corrections) in the above named bid.

Below are the questions received in reference to the above named bid and the corresponding answers.

Q1: Can we get a copy of the sign-in sheet?

A1: A copy of the mandatory pre-bid conference sign-in sheet is attached.

Q2: On the boardwalk - Location C - it is written in the RFP that we can only work from 0700-1100 and only five days to do the job. Can we work more days on this location within the hours indicated, and if no, why?

A2: There will be no additional days allowed for completion of work at Location "C" (Boardwalk CBD 70,000 SF). This schedule was adopted to insure a minimal impact to the business owners, residents and visitors.

Q3: The number of days that work is to take on other locations, can we work all day since there are no time restrictions stated? Can we work more days if needed?

A3: Location "A" (City Hall) work must be between 6am and 8am Monday thru Friday unless vendor's preference is to perform work on Saturday at which the hours will be from 8am till 5pm.

Location "B" (Holland Park) work must be between 8am and 5pm Monday thru Friday.

Q4: Boat Ramp: All cleaning is to stop at waters edge on the boat ramp. Is that correct?

A4: Yes, however must be done at low tide.

Q5: Seawall cleaning: Is this done from above, not from in the water?

A5: Yes, however must be done at low tide.

Q6: Can all wash water be washed into city drains?

A6: Yes.

Q7: Where does the contractor connect the rented water meter at the different site locations? Or does the contractor contact the city to schedule a connection?

A7: At hydrants or self contained.

Q8: Are the locations further than 50-100 feet from the worksite(s)? Or connected at more than one location throughout?

A8: Various locations.

Q9: Can the contractor use a subcontractor/supplier certified to install the MOT?

A9: Yes, MOT vendor must be noted in the bid submission.

Q10: In the event that existing stain over pavers could not be removed by pressure cleaning or chemical treatment, please clarify if contractor will be required to replace the stained pavers.

A10: NO.

Q11: Is it mandatory to the vendor arranged for a temporary meter through the City Water Department or is it ok if the vendor brings his own tanks of water?

A11: It is mandatory the vendor utilizes a temporary meter through the City of Hollywood’s Water Department. Tankers will not be allowed.

Q12: In reference to the above mentioned Bid, the pressure cleaning at City Hall 2600 Hollywood Blvd, the bid states soffit, parapet walls, breezeway, stairways & sidewalk but which building is this? Please specify the name of the building.

A12: City Hall Building.

CLARIFICATION:

C1: Item “H” on page 10 (Surf Road Pavers) states work shall be completed within 12 business days. Please change to “Work shall be completed within (2) business days.

All other specifications, terms & conditions remain the same.
