- Continued monitoring sea level rise effects on sea walls and give input Issues.
- Continued to research anchoring options in North and South Lake.
- Actively supported Waterway Clean-up activities.
- Reviewed existing Waterway Masterplan.

**GOALS 2023**

The Marine Advisory Board expects to:

- Attend joint meetings and Marine Summits as they occur to promote Hollywood's involvement in their waterways and become proactive on Marine issues.
- Actively support Waterway Clean-up activities.
- Promote the Annual Youth Fishing Tournament and Cardboard Boat Races.
- Promptly fill any vacancies by actively recruiting new members to the Board.
- Monitor anchoring options within the City limits.
- Promote and recommend water quality improvements

**ISSUES 2023**

The Marine Advisory Board is concerned with the following issues:

- Legislation on anchoring and how it will and is affecting the Marina and waterways in Hollywood, including dinghy docking.
- Concerns about sea level rise and the effects.
- Concerns with speed zones on the City's waterways.
- The condition of private seawalls adjacent to the city's waterways.
- Maintenance and upkeep of the public beach and the city's waterways.
- Concerned with water quality within the City's waterways.
- Monitor the proposed infrastructure of City Marina facility.
- Monitor ordinance changes affecting ocean and waterway environment.
- Loss of sea grass throughout the City waterways.
