### Hollywood Police Charge Four in Rehabilitation Center at Hollywood Hills Criminal Investigation

The Hollywood Police Department announces the arrest of four individuals in the criminal investigation of the 12 deaths at the Rehabilitation Center at Hollywood Hills.

The arrests and charges are as follows:

**JORGE CARBALLO, Facility Administrator**

12 counts of aggravated manslaughter (*first degree felony*)

**SERGO COLIN, Registered Nurse, Night Shift Nursing Supervisor**

12 counts of aggravated manslaughter (*first degree felony*)

**TAMIKA TORY MILLER, Licensed Practical Nurse**

6 counts of aggravated manslaughter (*first degree felony*)

3 counts of tampering with evidence in connection with patient medical records (*third degree felony*)

**ALTHIA KENESHA MEGGIE, Registered Nurse**

2 counts of aggravated manslaughter (*first degree felony*)

2 counts of tampering with evidence in connection with patient medical records (*third degree felony*)

We thank the families for their patience and understanding during this very difficult time,” said Hollywood Police Chief Chris O’Brien. “Through the hard work and dedication of the Detectives, Officers and Crime Scene personnel of the Hollywood Police Department, the Attorney General, Office of the State Attorney, the Agency for Health Care Administration, the Department of Health and Human Services; today we announced the arrest of the four individuals. The Hollywood Police Department has worked closely with partner agencies to ensure a complete, careful and comprehensive investigation to equip prosecutors with the ability to successfully hold those responsible accountable.”

The Hollywood Police Department remains diligent in investigating all aspects of this case and additional arrests are anticipated. Throughout this investigation, the Department has prioritized thoroughness and accuracy over a rapid resolution. The primary focus has always been on justice for the victims and their families.
