Updates from the City Commission Meeting

The City of Hollywood is conducting its Regular City Commission Meetings in-person at City Hall, located at 2600 Hollywood Boulevard. While public access to City Hall and City facilities has resumed, please know that seating inside the Commission Chambers is limited and facial masks are recommended but not required for City employees and visitors.

CITY COMMISSION MEETING

The City Commission Meeting started with a special moment of silence to remember the life of Treatment Plant Mechanic II Erick Johnson who was the victim of senseless gun violence. Erick died on Tuesday, August 30th. With 27 years of dedicated service to the City of Hollywood, Erick was a beloved member of the Public Utilities Department. The City of Hollywood extends our deepest condolences to the Johnson family.



City Commission Approves Sidewalk and ADA Compliance Projects

The Mayor and City Commission voted unanimously to approve Resolutions [R-2022-223](#) and [R-2022-225](#) to authorize City officials to negotiate contracts with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. for the design of the Sidewalk and ADA Compliance Projects for Beverly Park, Hollywood Beach Heights, and Hollywood Country Estates. These projects, which will improve pedestrian safety and help complete the citywide sidewalk network, are a part of the Complete Streets and other Localized Initiatives Program grant, and funding will be provided by the Florida Department of Transportation Local Agency Program.

State Road 7 Linear Park and Mobility Hub Improvements Project Approved

The Mayor and City Commission voted unanimously to approve Resolution [R-2022-226](#) to authorize city officials to execute a contract with MBR Construction, Inc. for the construction of the State Road 7 Linear Park Improvements. This project will complement the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) roadway system, on City's rights-of-way, by adding landscaping, lighting, and other improvements to enhance the pedestrian experience along the State Road 7 corridor.

In addition, the Mayor and City Commission voted unanimously to approve Resolutions [R-2022-227](#) and [R-2022-228](#) to execute maintenance agreements with the FDOT for improvements on the Hollywood Boulevard/State Road 7 Mobility Hub and State Road 7 Linear Park.

ORDINANCES

Ordinance Approved to Vacate a Portion of the Alley Within Block 8, Hudson Village

On second reading, the Mayor and City Commission voted unanimously to approve Ordinance [PO-2022-13](#) to vacate a portion of the alley within Block 8, also known as Hudson Village, and recreate it with access to Washington Street.

Ordinance Approved on First Reading to Amend Distribution of Handbills

The Mayor and City Commission voted unanimously to approve Ordinance [PO-2022-15](#) to amend Chapter 112 of the Code of Ordinances regarding the distribution of handbills and other advertising materials. On first reading, this ordinance amendment aims to hold publishers and distributors responsible for maintaining newspaper boxes throughout the City. In addition, this amendment allows residents to opt-out of receiving unsolicited publications.

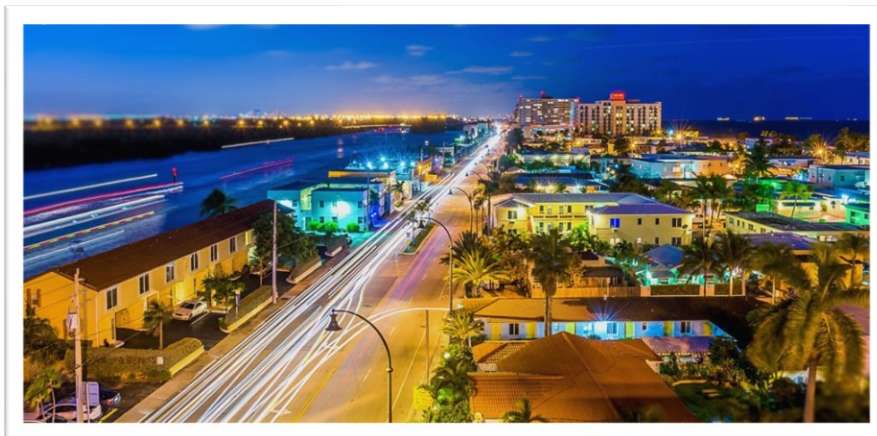
Ordinance Approved on First Reading to Reduce the Maximum Fine for Lobbyists

The Mayor and City Commission voted unanimously to approve Ordinance [PO-2022-16](#) to decrease the maximum fine amount that lobbyists pay for a late annual disclosure statement. Currently, any lobbyist who fails to file the annual disclosure statement is subject to a fine of \$50.00 per day for each late day, not to exceed a total fine of \$5,000.00. This Ordinance amendment will reduce the maximum fine from \$5,000 to \$500.00.

Ordinance for Development Impact Fees Approved on First Reading

The Mayor and City Commission approved Ordinance [PO-2022-17](#) to repeal the current Park Impact Fees and Ordinance [PO-2022-18](#) to create a development impact fee provision encompassing the adoption of impact fees for general government buildings, fire rescue, law enforcement, parks and recreation, and multi-modal transportation. Impact fees are one-time capital charge to new development that cover the cost of new capacity and help the City maintain its level of service.

The City adopted a parks and recreation impact fee in 2013, which needs to be updated. On First Reading, these ordinances provide for revised parks and recreation impact fees and the implementation of impact fees for additional service areas including fire rescue, law enforcement, general government buildings, and transportation (multi-modal). GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND PROJECTS

City Commission Approves Environmental Services for the Hollywood Beach Golf Course and Clubhouse/Community Center

The Mayor and City Commission unanimously approved Resolution [R-2022-229](#) for supplemental environmental engineering services at the Hollywood Beach Golf Course and Clubhouse. Langan Engineering and Environmental Services, Inc. conducted the first phase of environmental services and will now provide an assessment of areas of impacted soil and groundwater, as needed for regulatory closure and redevelopment support, and to prepare plans to remediate the identified impacts during construction. Improvements of the Hollywood Beach Golf Course and Clubhouse is part of the City's General Obligation Bond, which was approved by voters in March 2019.

Renovation of the Holland Park Restrooms Approved

The Mayor and City Commission unanimously approved Resolution [R-2022-230](#) to renovate the Holland Park restrooms. The project, which was approved by voters in the City's General Obligation Bond in March 2019, includes interior demolition of existing restroom partitions, floor tiles, wall tiles, plumbing fixtures, electrical fixtures and mechanical fixtures.

PRESENTATIONS, PROCLAMATIONS AND AWARDS

Chief's Special Recognition Award Presented to Kyanne Anderson and Zoey Phillips

In the early morning hours of July 20, 2022, Hollywood Hills High School Seniors Kyanne Anderson and Zoey Phillips were watching the sunrise and taking photos on Hollywood Beach. While there, they noticed a young boy alone, with his Ipad, near with water. Kyanne and Zoey approached the boy, who was non-verbal, then called the police only to learn that the boy's mother reported him missing at around the same time. Due to their level of concern, attentive actions and compassion, the boy was safely reunited with his mother. With representatives from the Broward County School Board and Hollywood Hills High School administrators, Police Chief Chris O'Brien presented Kyanne and Zoey with the Chief's Special Recognition Award. On behalf of the City of Hollywood, we extend our gratitude to these two young ladies who saved the boy's life.



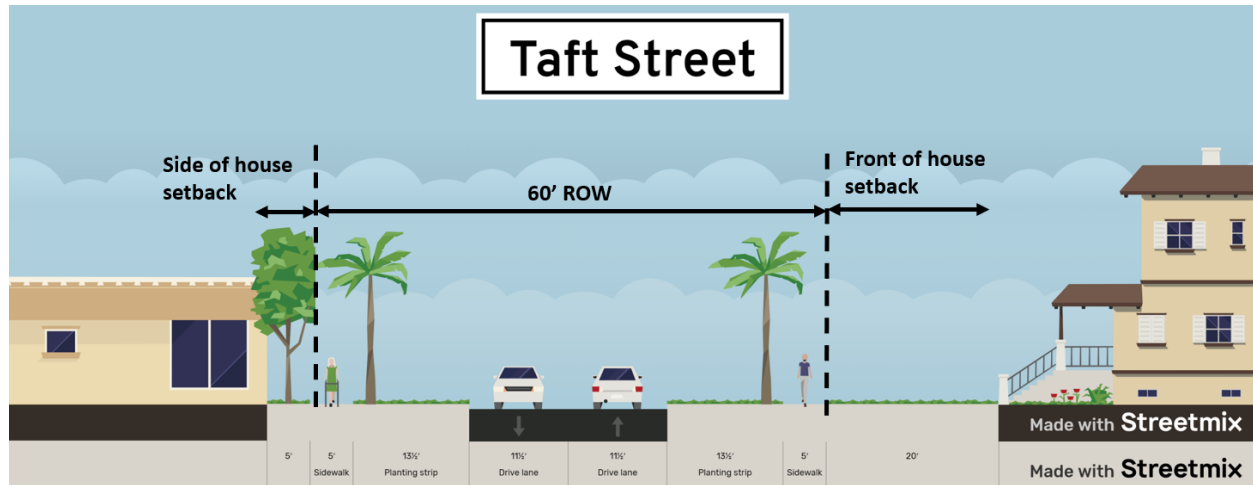
Suicide Prevention Awareness Month

The Mayor and City Commission presented Barbara Markley of the League of Women Voters of Broward County with a proclamation for National Suicide Prevention Awareness Month. Taft Street Mobility Improvement Project

City Engineer Azita Behmardi along with representatives from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) presented plans for mobility improvements along Taft Street, from State Road 7 to North 40th Avenue. As a result of feedback from stakeholders and the community, the improvements will include a shared use path on the north side of Taft Street with lighting. - **Monkeypox/Smallpox Vaccinations:** The City of Hollywood continues to partner with the Florida Department of Health to host a Monkeypox vaccination site within the City at the David Park Community Center, 108 N. 33rd Court. The initial dose of vaccinations concluded last week and the 2nd dose of the vaccine is scheduled to be administered at the Center from September 12th through September 23rd. Previously the site required appointments, but the health department has announced it will accept walk-ins at this vaccination site for those needing a first dose during the Sept 12-23 session.
