CITY COMMISSION MEETING

City Commission Accepts Certified Results of the 2022 General and Special Elections

The Mayor and City Commission voted unanimously to approve Resolution [R-2022-349](#) to accept the certified results of the 2022 General and Special Elections. Commissioner Caryl Shuham, District 1, and Commissioner Idelma Quintana, District 6, were elected without opposition.

Commissioner Quintana was elected to fill the unexpired term for District 6 Commissioner Linda Sherwood, who retired after 14 years on the dais.

Commissioners Shuham, Traci Callari, District 3, and Kevin Biederman, District 5, were re-elected to four-year terms.
