CITY COMMISSION MEETING

City Commission Approves Ranking of Firms for Orangebrook Golf Course Redevelopment

During the January 18th City Commission Meeting, four firms presented their Best and Final Offers (BAFOs) to the Mayor and City Commission. A lengthy discussion ensued, and Resolution [R-2023-028](#) was continued to the March 1st City Commission Meeting to allow staff to re-score/re-rank the firms based on new information that was presented in the meeting.

After a brief presentation by staff, public comments, and discussion among the Mayor and City Commission, Resolution [R-2023-028](#) was approved with a 4-3 vote to rank the firms as follows:

1. GCF Development LLC/PPG Development LLC
2. E2L Real Estate Solutions, LLC
3. Ernie Els Group

City staff will now begin to negotiate an agreement with the top-ranked firm. As a reminder, the City of Hollywood received an unsolicited proposal submitted under the provisions of the State of Florida's Public-Private Partnerships ("P3") statute (*Section 255.065, F.S.*) for Orangebrook Golf Course Redevelopment.
