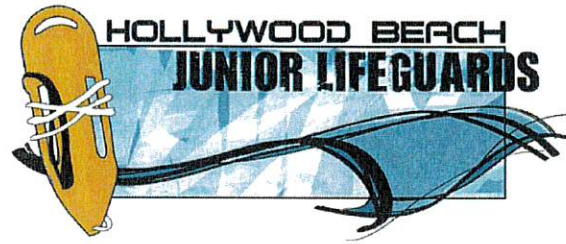


# Hollywood Fire Rescue / Beach Safety Division

Junior lifeguards will be issued a t-shirt and a pair of shorts as part of their enrollment.

## **ALL Applicants!**

All applicants must possess an above average swimming ability to participate in all activities in this program.

## REFUND POLICY

Refunds will be issued if a class is cancelled or if this office receives a notice of cancellation no later than five (5) working days prior to the first class. Refunds will also be issued if the participant is unable to pass the swim test.

## ITEMS TO BRING

We recommend that sunscreen be worn at all times. There are also facilities to change so you may bring a change of clothes and a towel. We will provide water and Gatorade to drink. You may also bring your own food and drink.

## CAMP LOCATION

On the Monday of each weekly session our Junior Lifeguard camp will assemble behind the Hollywood Beach Community Center, 1301 S. Ocean Drive – under the pavilion - where uniforms will be issued
